

## REPORT

DSCW NSS wing in collaboration with Ek Bharat Shreshthta Bharat, under the patronage of chairman Shriman Nirmal Singh Ji Dhillon and Dr. Sangeeta, Officiating Principal, DSCW, organized a cycle rally, painting competition, symposium and a Nukkad Natak "Inquilab Aje Baki Hai" to celebrate 115th Birth Anniversary of Shaheed Bhagat Singh.

The Event commenced at 7.30 in the morning with the cycle rally which was flagged off by Shri Darshan Singh S/O Shri Ram Singh Panchi, a freedom fighter who accompanied Sardar Bhagat Singh in the struggle for Independence. During the flag off ceremony, Dr. Sangeeta, Officiating Principal, Mrs. Sapna, Nodal Officer, Mrs. Rupinderjit Kaur, NSS Programme Officer and Mrs. Rabia, NSS Programme Officer raised slogans along with the staff members and students of Inquilab Zindabad to reminisce the memory of Shaheed Bhagat Singh. The students also carried portrait of Bhagat Singh and posters with freedom related slogans and raised slogans to energise the event. At the end of the rally, Dr. Sangeeta addressed the gathering in the college ground where she shared the contribution and sacrifice of the revolutionary freedom fighter Sardar Bhagat Singh.
